How the funds were used

The gift to Unity from the 100+ Women Who Care was used to:

- provide care for those facing end-of-life illness in Door County
- provide Grief Support to those facing the loss of a loved one
- to ensure patients on Washington Island had access to the same level of care as people in the Sturgeon Bay area.



Across the year with this funding, Unity served:

- 279 patients in Door County; 127 male and 152 female.
- The majority of those served were ages 60 and above, but there were several in their 40's and 50's.

Overall house calls:

- Unity's nurses made nearly 5000
- CNAs made over 3000
- Social workers 2000
- Chaplains 1200
- Grief support 150.



You not only helped people remain at home during their illness, but also helped:

- Five patients receive 24-hour care at the Jack and Engrid Meng Hospice Residence in De Pere.
- Made sure 12 families in Door County received compassionate grief support after the death of their loved one.
- You also helped make sure four patients on Washington Island received the care and support they needed without having to leave the island!





Average "Age" of Nonprofit in the Hat





New Nonprofit Hat/Eligibility

We have been monitoring the age of the hat, and listening to your feedback.

- Concerns that some nonprofits are getting 'stuck in hat'.
- Concerns that prior award recipients are coming back in the hat before other nonprofits have received first award.



Two Changes Effective January 2024

- 1. Increase "wait time" out of the hat from 2 years to 3 (same as main award recipient).
- 2. Annually, as needed, in the January meeting pull all 3 nonprofits from an "Aged hat". (Aged hat = in hat for 3+ years).

Increases the opportunity for both for award \$ and organization awareness for those nonprofits not yet awarded.
